Footnote:

The attack on Fungwha formed part of the suppression on the Taiping Rebellion (1850-64). The action was conducted by troops from HMS Sphynx and Encounter assisted by a Philippine force. The battle was fiercely fought and Able Seaman George Hinckley of HMS Sphynx received a Victoria Cross for his conspicuous bravery during the

The event was reported in the Illustrated London News of 7 February 1863 and illustrated with a print similar to the above work. A drawing by the same hand entitled Bombardment of the East Gate by field pieces of HMS Encounter and Sphinx is in the collection of the National Maritime Museum, Greenwich.

A.D. McArthur served as an officer aboard HMS Encounter.
