Aleksandr Mikhailovich (1866-1893), grandson of Tsar Nicholas I and brother-in-law of Nicholas II, served as a naval officer in the Russian Fleet. The fine chromolithographed views depict grand yachts, gun ships and cruisers of the fleet at sea. The technical details (weight, dimensions, artillery, etc.) are provided in Russian and French on the verso.
