SEVENTEEN MERITORIOUS GENERALS AND OFFICIALS

handscroll; ink and color on paper

With a lengthy frontispiece by the Emperor Qianlong (r. 1736–1797), dated Qianlong bing shen, 1776, summer, fifth month. The seventeen portraits are interspersed with calligraphy by the Emperor identifying the individuals, and noting their meritorious deeds. With fourteen seals of the Emperor, Yong Bi Zai Xin, Xu Zhong Cheng Zhao, He Guang Ji Zhong, Wu Fu Wu Dai Tang Gu Xi Tian Zi Bao, Ba Zheng Mao Nian Zhi Bao, Qian Long, Ji Xian Lin Chi, Tai Shang Huang Di Zhi Bao, Shi Qu Bao Ji Suo Cang, and five others

12 by 2191/2 in. 30.5 by 557.5 cm.

This is the first section from one of a set of handscrolls which originally consisted of fifty portraits. Several sets of portraits were commissioned by the Qianlong Emperor, in both hanging scroll and handscroll formats. 
Wang Su, from Taicang, Jiangsu, was a nephew of Wang Yuangi and one of the Lesser Four Wangs
